Secretary of State Jim Condos Attended the National Association of Secretaries of State's 2016 Winter Conference

Montpelier, VT – Secretary of State Jim Condos joined 33 other Secretaries and industry leaders in Washington, DC from Wednesday, February 11th to Friday, February 13th at the National Secretary of State's Association Conference. The conference connected state capitals and allowed Secretaries to discuss topics and share their latest initiatives ranging from elections to business services.

Secretary of State Jim Condos sits on the Executive Board as well as the Elections, Voter Participation, Business Services, and State Heritage Committees. "I was pleased to meet with my colleagues from across the US to discuss best practices in the areas of common interest among Secretaries of State - increasing voter participation, integrity of our elections process, and business identity theft," states Secretary Condos.

The nation's Secretaries of State also focused on federal and state policy initiatives for the 2016 presidential election cycle, staying ahead of civic and voter technology challenges, best practices in public outreach and media relations, citizen archivist initiatives, and voter registration advances.
