



## Applied Behavior Analyst

### Instructions for Licensure as an Applied Behavior Analyst

#### A. EXAMINATION

1. Complete Vermont Application
2. Application Fee of \$100.00 (Non-Refundable Processing Fee)
3. Submit a copy of your BCBA or BCBA-D certification from the Behavior Analyst Certification Board.

OR

Official transcripts reflecting attainment of a doctoral or master's degree from an educational program accredited by the Association for Behavior Analysis International Accreditation Board or approved by the Director, and

Documentation reflecting successful completion of an approved practicum or supervised experience in the practice of applied behavior analysis, totaling at least 1,500 hours over a period of not less than one calendar year, of which at least 75 hours involved in direct one-to-one contact with a supervisor, and

Verification of passing an examination in the principles and practice of applied behavior analysis adopted from the BACB and approved by the Director.

#### B. ENDORSEMENT

1. Complete Vermont Application
2. Application Fee of \$100.00 (Non-Refundable Processing Fee)
3. Submit a copy of your BCBA or BCBA-D certification from the Behavior Analyst Certification Board.

OR

Official transcripts reflecting attainment of a doctoral or master's degree from an educational program accredited by the Association for Behavior Analysis International Accreditation Board or approved by the Director, and

Documentation reflecting successful completion of an approved practicum or supervised experience in the practice of applied behavior analysis, totaling at least 1,500 hours over a period of not less than one calendar year, of which at least 75 hours involved in direct one-to-one contact with a supervisor, and

Verification of passing an examination in the principles and practice of applied behavior analysis adopted from the BACB and approved by the Director.

4. Provide verification of licensure as a Behavior Analyst in another jurisdiction, including verification of your original state of licensure as well as the license from your most recent state of employment

#### C. TRANSITIONAL – Expires July 1, 2017

1. Complete Vermont Application
2. Application Fee of \$100.00 (Non-Refundable Processing Fee)
3. Official transcripts reflecting attainment of a doctoral or master's degree in behavior analysis or a related field.
4. Submit a work portfolio demonstrating verifiable training, experience, and competency equivalent to that expected of a licensee. At a minimum, such a portfolio shall include:
  - a full professional resume, including all employment in the past ten years and supervisor contacts;
  - a professional-development narrative explaining the nature and extent of behavior-analyst practice;
  - other documentation verifying competence in the field, and any requested by the Office.
