Position Statement

My presence in the 2018 campaign for governor of Vermont is for the sole purpose of encouraging more people to plan for a complete transformation of our methods of political governance. As a woman, the legal basis of this country has little bearing for me, it was created by the patriarchy at a time when light bulbs were still a thing of the future.
